#### DESCRIPTION

Extra strong water-based cleaner, suitable for intensive degreasing treatments in the context of extraordinary maintenance. The product is indicated for removing stubborn dirt, greasy deposits, moulds, dark patinas, residues of old oils and impregnating agents even on large areas.

If diluted in water it allows for a more gentle cleaning, such as preliminary degreasing treatments on exotic woods. In this case it is recommended to dilute the product 1:1 with water. Wet the support with plenty of water before treatment.

It can alter the natural color of the wood making it darker. To restore the original color of the wood, use Exterior Wood Cleaner.





# SURFACE PREPARATION

Wet the surface to be treated abundantly with water in order to slow down the drying of the detergent and prolong its action. It is recommended not to carry out the treatment with temperatures below 10°C or above 35°C.

#### HOW TO USE



Apply with a brush (preferably synthetic) in a slight excess, forming an abundant layer.



Leave on for 15-30 min.

Ensure surface remains wet, spraying gently with water if necessary or reapplying a small amount of product.



Massage the surface with a stiff synthetic brush.



Rinse thoroughly with water, with the help of a high pressure pump.



Wait until the substrate is completely dry before applying a finishing product.

### **TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS**

### Shake before use.

Wear protective gloves.

Preferably use synthetic bristle brushes and brushes.

After drying and sanding, the overpainting with water-based products is not recommended.

It is advisable not to apply in direct sunlight, on hot surfaces, in the presence of strong winds, rain, fog or with the risk of night frosts. Carry out a preliminary test on a hidden area to check if the final effect corresponds to the desired one.

#### **RECOMMEDED CYCLES**

To complete the work cycle, the following products are recommended:

- 1. Exterior Wood Cleaner cod. 0075 as a neutralizing cleaner
- 2. **Terrace Oil** code 4971-IL as finishing oil for terraces
- Teak Oil cod.0360 as treatment oil for garden furniture
- 4. Decking Oil HD (code 4971XX) or Decking Oil 2K (code 49712K)
